**Description Of Project:**

The Rawlins BLM would like to request funding support to replace two existing wildlife guzzlers in the Seminole Mountains. The guzzler were originally designed and installed in the 1980's and had to have their lids (tops) replaced in 2012 after the Seminole wildfire. The existing guzzlers area a parabolic design that collect water from the guzzler lids surface area only. The current designs do not take advantage of any additional collection surface area from an apron system similar to the most recent designs installed in the Ferris Mountains.

The existing guzzlers tanks are beginning to dilapidate in additional areas that were impacted by the 2012 wildfire. As a result, the existing tanks have collected lots of sediment material including some fiberglass material, which is the original makeup of the existing guzzlers.

**Problem to be Solved:**

The existing dilapidating guzzlers need to be replaced with new modified designs that can collect and store more water than the current designs.

**Describe How You Propose Solving the Problem:**

Each of the two existing wildlife guzzler will need to be taken apart and removed. They will then be replaced with guzzler designs similar to those installed in the Seminole Mountains by WWSF volunteers during July of 2017. Each new guzzler will be capable of storing 800 gallons of water and will include an additional collection aprons to take advantage of precipitation events during dry summer months.


