Bighorn Classroom Campaign Goal \$375,000

- Total raised (donated & pledged) as of April 2019: \$279,560
- Remaining: \$95,440
 - \$50,440 matching plus additional \$45,000 to reach goal
- Thank you to the Wyoming Community Foundation for awarding a \$25,000 year-end matching grant for all donations received by December 31, 2019.
- Raised \$90,000 from four Dubois-Area Foundations, matching grants plus all Center Board & Staff have contributed to our classroom campaign.
- Final architectural plans expected by early May.
