Project Title: 2019 Devil's Canyon to Ferris Transplant

Project Description: Capture 40 bighorn sheep in Devil's Canyon and transplant to Ferris Mountains in Winter 2018-2019.

All captured bighorns will be fitted with Globalstar satellite tracking collars or VHF collars deployed on each sheep to track daily movements and for continued disease surveillance.

Project Problem: Bighorn population in Devil's Canyon continues to be over objective, with no current options for increasing harvest. Ferris Mountains is a newly established bighorn herd and is still under objective, with ample bighorn sheep habitat available.

Problem Solution: Helicopter capture of 40 bighorns. VHF or GPS collar all captured bighorns prior to release.

Truck/trailer bighorns to Ferris Mountains for release. *This application is identical in content to previous Devil's to Ferris/Seminole Transplant requests.
